**NOTE**: All Guests aged 5 and over who have traveled through China or Hong Kong to embark in Doha (Qatar) will be required to: 1) perform a PCR test within 48 hours prior to departure from China or Hong Kong 2) perform an additional antigen or PCR test within 48 hours prior to boarding the ship

Note: children under 18 who meet these requirements are considered fully vaccinated

Who can not embark?

Partially vaccinated, recovered and unvaccinated

Is the pre-embarkation test necessary?

Yes, at <mark>48h</mark> for all guests aged 5 years and over

## **Vaccination status**



What is a fully vaccinated Guest?

Guests belonging to one of the following case:

- 2 doses + 1 booster
- 2 doses + recovered
- 1 dose J&J+ booster
- Recovery + 1 dose of J&J

Guests belonging to one of the following case:

- 2 doses
- 1 dose + recovery
- Recovery + 1 dose
